



## PLAY READING: THE COST OF EGGS by Yamina Bakiri, directed by Tarek Iskander

Set in war torn Syria, this play by **Yamina Bakiri** tells the story of a mother who painstakingly tries to hold her family together in a country that is falling apart. Presented in collaboration with Sandpit Productions, this is the first of two readings showcasing emerging Arab playwrights.

**Yamina Bakiri** is a neuroscientist and writer. She is the author of the on-going one-woman show *It's Nothing Personal*, which uses the stage as a playground to reflect on current affairs in the Middle East and Arab world from a woman's perspective.

**Tarek Iskander** is a freelance writer, director and dramaturg for theatre. He was a founder and Associate Artistic Director of the Yard Theatre, Hackney and is currently Resident Director at the National Theatre Studio.
